Course with an annual intake of 50 (Fifty) only on 16/12/2023 in the name of Modern College of Education, Post/Kinara No-1481, Plot No. 1481 Street Number-Kurama, Vill- Kurama, Bijnour, Post Office-Nawara (Bijnour), Tehsil-Taluk-Lucknow, Town/City- Lucknow, Dist- Lucknow, State-UP, Pin-227101.

AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/scrutiny of veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavits and the report received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including videography, the Northern Regional Committee in its 225th meeting held on 15th February to 15th March, 2024 is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the D.El.Ed. programme such as infrastructural facilities, instructional facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and its related apparatus duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

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- 6(i) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is recognised institution as per the definition of recognised institution given in the NCCT Regulation 2014. If a group of institutions is considered that the institution is not a corporate institution, the recognition granted will be treated as individual and the sole responsibility of the owner will be of the institution. 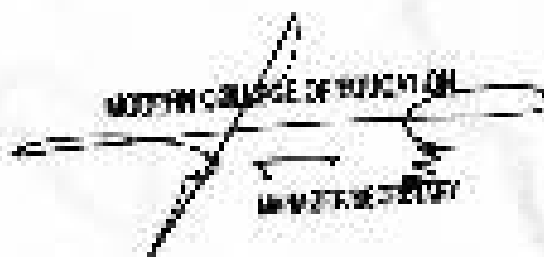

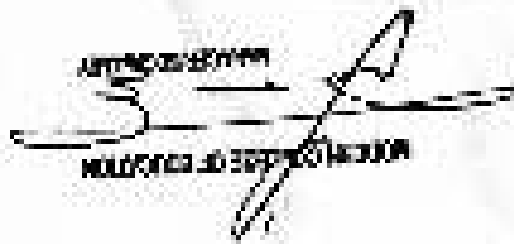

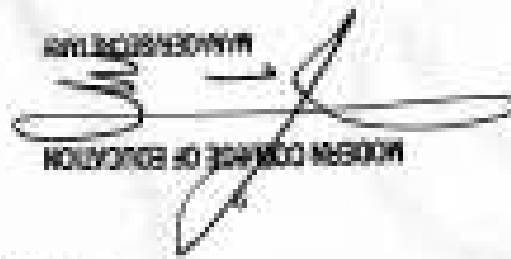
